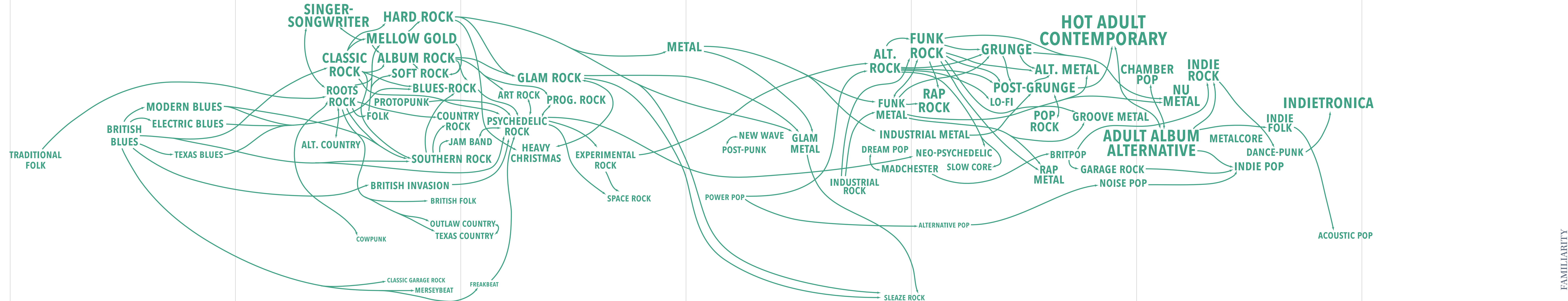


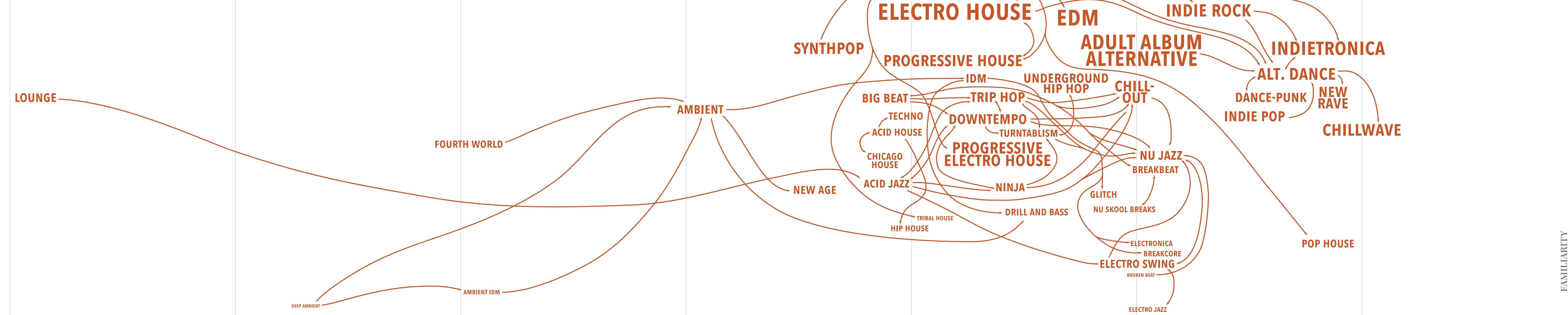

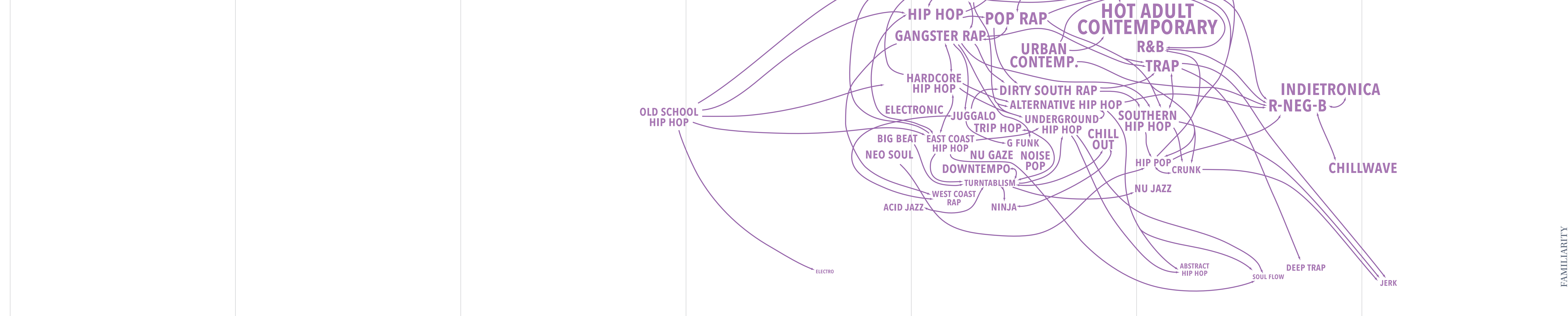

# Mapping Musical Genres

This composite graphic depicts the development of (and the associations between) major music genres from 1940 to 2000 using data from the EchoNest music database.

Each genre is linked to its influences and to its derivatives. The genres are placed on a time axis based on the earliest activity of their popular & representative artists. Type size is used to represent the *current popularity* of a genre (EchoNest's "hottness" metric), while vertical position within each section of the three-part graphic represents *historical popularity* (in other words, how "familiar" that kind of music is in the world).
